BEETS

Bulls Blood Large, purplish red beets with edible red foliage. 2-3" fruit, 40-52 days.

BROCCOLI

Early Dream Large-domed, tight-beaded, heat tolerant variety that matures in 59 days.

Green Magic Medium-sized smooth broccoli heads that are 5-6" large. Heat-tolerant. 57 days.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Jade Cross An early hybrid (80 days) with uniform growth and delicious taste! 80 days.

CABBAGE

Bravo A well-rounded, heat and cold tolerant, blue-green hybrid cabbage. 85 days.

CELERY

Cutting Flavor-packed leafy herb used in salads, soups and stews. 80-85 days

CUCUMBER

Boston Pickling 6" self fertile, that is a favorite amongst home gardeners. Matures in 54 Days.

Marketmore 76 Long, slender, dark green cucumbers. Has been the standard for slicing cucumbers with 8-9" fruits. Begins bearing late but picks for a relatively long time. 63 days

EGGPLANT

Classic Egg-shaped, purple to green fruit 6-9" long. 65-85 days

Hanzel All-American Selections winner, great for containers, 4-8" fruit with little seeds that matures in 55 days.

KALE

- Dynasaur Also know as Tuscan kale, rich in flavor, this blue-green colored kale is one of the best! 55-60 days.
- Scarlet Ruffled, reddish purple, tightly curled leaf, ready to pick in 80 days.
- Red Russian The best early season and late season leafy green you could ask for! Ornamental red stems make this perfect for planting within flowers. 55-60 days.

LETTUCE

- Bistro Gourmet Mix A nice variety of color and leaf types, a great option for the all-around salad greens. Matures in 55 Days.
- Blushed Icy Oak Red and green colored lettuce with a snappy crunch. 50-55 days.
- Buttercrunch All-American Selections winner with lush leafy greens and a buttery texture. 60-65 days.

MOUSE MELON

- Mouse Melon / Cucamelon / Mexican Sour Gherkin A snack-sized cucumber with melon resemblance. A vining growth makes this a great new addition to your gardenscapes. Trellis for easy picking. 70-75 days.

PEPPER

- Golden California Wonder Smooth, blocky 4" fruit, sweet and mild flavor, turn light green to light yellow. 62-73 days
- Hungarian Cheese Blend A great snacking/stuffing pepper of varying color during maturity. Fruit size is roughly 4" and has a quick maturity of 60 days.
- Purple Beauty Guaranteed to catch the eye, these roughly 4" fruit have a rich deep purple appearance and great bell flavor. 65-70 days.
- Sweet Banana A very popular large-pointed pepper roughly 6-7" in size. Mild in heat and flavor, they have a variety of culinary purpose. They are most popular as a pickling pepper. 70 days.

PEPPER - SPICY

Habanero	Very hot, spicy and smokey quality good for chilis and hot sauces. Plants produce many 1-2" fruits, 95-100 days.
Jalapeno	The most popular chili pepper in America. 3" thick walled fruit mature in 72 days with varying green and red coloration. Mild heat. 60-80 (based on color).
Poblano	A mildly hot, 4" dark purple/green pepper perfect for roasting and stuffing. Dry to make ancho peppers. 65 days.
Red Cherry Hot	Small 1-2" fruit that are mild when green, and much hotter as they mature to a dark red. 80 days.

SQUASH - SUMMER

Gold Summer Crook Neck	Very prolific, best picked at 4-6" size, smooth-skinned golden yellow fruit. Full fruit size of 8-10" and matures in 50 days.
Straight Neck	Heirloom, prolific blooming, creamy yellow, straight-neck squash. Great for grilling. Fruit size is 4 to 10" and matures quickly in 46-52 days.
Yellow Bush Scallop	Also known as golden custard squash, rich in flavor and are 2-3" in size. 50 days

SQUASH - WINTER

Delicata	Similar flavor to a sweet potato these cream-colored winter squash are oblong in shape with beautiful green striping. Squash are 6" long x 3" diameter, 80-100 days.
Honey Bear Acorn	Medium-sized acorn squash are roughly 1-2lbs. They have a wonderful sweet starchy texture good for baking and stuffing. This variety was bred for powdery mildew resistance. 85 days
Waltham Butternut	Heirloom, with a hard yellow to tan exterior and sweet orange flesh. Winter squash size is 1 to 3 lb and matures in 82 days.

ZUCCHINI

Elite	This early zucchini has impressive yields and is easy to pick. 7-8" in length and mature in 48 days.

TOMATO

Beefmaster	Huge meaty fruits are amazing for slicing and sandwiches. Tolerant of cracking with a mild and sweet flavor. Hybrid, indeterminate. 80 days.
Brandywine Red	Overall winner of flavor, these beefsteak-shaped, boat-like fruit are 12-16 oz in size and mature in 90 days. Indeterminate.
Bush Early Girl	Extra large, super early tomato, roughly 3-4" in size, has proven to be resistant to many common tomato diseases. Great for patio planters, 6oz fruit, and mature in 65 days. Determinate.
Celebrity	Versatile disease resistant, great flavor tomato with average fruit size of 7 oz. 70 days maturity. Determinate.
Cherokee Purple	Large, dark purple heirloom beefsteak tomato variety with a great smokey full flavor. 12-16 oz. fruit size, 85 day maturity. Indeterminate.
Green Zebra	This delicious heirloom slicer tomato is mottled with emerald green and orange-yellow skin. Fruit are 6-10 oz and mature in 78 days. Indeterminate.
Heirloom Rainbow Blend	An old fashion 80-100 day very flavorful variety of yellow, green, and red tomatoes. Medium size at 6-10 oz. Indeterminate.
Mountain Merit	A classic disease and pest resistant, All-America Selections regional winner, 'Mountain Merit' is a perfect determinate producer. Weighing in at 8-10 oz, mild flavor, it has a strong heat tolerance. 75 days.
Peardrops	These orange, tangy-flavored fruits are distinctly pear-shaped and plants are heavy yielding. Fruit are 2-4 oz, and reach full maturity in 75 days. Indeterminate.

TOMATO - CHERRY

Midnight Snack	All-America Selections winner, this prolific cherry tomato has a beautiful purple and red color, and packs a flavorful punch. Matures in 68-75 days and is indeterminate.
Sunsugar	Sweet-tart-flavored cherry tomato that produces all season long. Golden orange fruit roughly 1 oz. in size mature in 65 days. Indeterminate.
Super Sweet 100	Very sweet, scarlet-colored cherry size fruit are 1 oz and mature in 70 days. Indeterminate.

WATERMELON

Sugar Baby	Sweet, medium-red flesh, round in shape and average 6-12 lbs. A good option for a short growing season. 75 day maturity.
