***DIOSPYROS VIGINIANA 'GOLDEN DELIGHT'**

Persimmon • ZONE 4, HT 35-60', SP 20-35', SUN/PT SUN

This cultivar of the American persimmon was selected not only for the large, tasty fruit, which are almost double the average, but for the fact that they are produced much earlier, a boon for northern gardeners. Tolerant of pollution and clay soils.

FRAGARIA A. 'PINEBERRY'

Everbearing Strawberry • ZONE 4-9, HT 8", SUN

These are quite unusual and hard to find! White with red seeds, they taste like pineapple strawberries. They are everbearing so you can enjoy all summer long. Needs another everbearing variety for pollination.

FRAGARIA VESCA 'ALEXANDRIA'

Woodland Strawberry • ZONE 5-9, 6-10", SUN/ PART SUN

This strawberry is grown for both its tasty berries and runnerless compact habit. Ample water provides prolific, tiny, and extremely fragrant and sweet berries packed with sugar! Everbearing so they will produce fruit from spring to fall.

***GAYLUSSACIA BACCATA**

Black Huckleberry • ZONE 4, HT 1-3', SP 1-3', SUN/ PT SHADE

An underused native edible that does well in a variety of conditions. Fruits resemble blueberries in appearance and flavor but usually ripen later in the wild. Great flowers for pollinators and anticipated fall foliage for gardeners.

LONICERA CAERULEA 'INDIGO GEM'

Honeyberry • ZONE 2, HT 4-5', SP 3-4', SUN

A honeyberry from the U. of Saskatchewan bred for high yields of the great tasting, early season fruit. Can be eaten fresh, dried, or made into preserves. Requires another variety for pollination. Tolerates poor soils and clay soils.

MALUS 'GOLDEN SENTINEL'

Columnar Dwarf Apple • ZONE 4, HT 8-12', SP 2-3', SUN

Unique and delicious apple, perfect for patio planters or space-efficient gardens. 'Golden Sentinel' is a strong but refined grower that flowers and fruits right on the trunk. Pair with its columnar companion, 'Scarlet Sentinel', for pollination.

MALUS 'GRAVENSTEIN'

Heirloom Apple • ZONE 4, HT 12-15', SP 12-15', SUN

An heirloom variety that likely originated in late 18th century Denmark, 'Gravenstein' is reliably hardy, and produces good crops of deep yellow fruit with attractive red striping. Popular for cooking and eating fresh.

MALUS 'SCARLET SENTINEL'

Columnar Apple • ZONE 4, HT 8-10', SP 1-2', SUN

The perfect edible solution for those with limited garden space. This apple tree rarely branches, but instead produces fruit on spurs along the trunk. The large yellow-red fruit ripens in late September. Plant with 'Golden Sentinel' as a pollinator.

MALUS X 'SPITZENBERG'

Heirloom Apple • ZONE 4, HT 12-15', SP 12-15', SUN

Perhaps the highest regarded American apple. This was reported to be Thomas Jefferson's favorite. Large fruit with red skin, and crisp, aromatic flesh. It is good for eating, cooking and storing, with best flavor developing a few weeks after harvest.

RUBUS 'JOAN J'

Thornless Raspberries • ZONE 4, HT 4-5', SP 2-3', SUN

Love tasty raspberries but don't like thorns? Then this everbearing cultivar is for you. Self-fertile and disease-resistant, 'Joan J' produces bumper crops of sweet, firm berries that will have you coming back for more. Long-lasting harvest time.

RUBUS 'POLKA'

Raspberry • ZONE 4, HT 4-5', SP 2-3', SUN

Bred to be highly resistant to root rot, 'Polka' is a mostly thornless cultivar that fruits early in the season. Very large fruit are described as being exceptionally sweet. Self-fertile but we recommend planting with 'Joan J' for truly bountiful harvests.
