***ARONIA MELANOCARPA 'LOW SCAPE HEDGER'**

Black Chokeberry • ZONE 3, HT 3-5', SP 2-3', SUN/PT SUN

A more formal version of a tough and versatile native, 'Low Scape Hedger' is perfect for small borders and screens. Abundant white flowers in spring, and handsome disease-resistant foliage that turns a wonderful array of colors in autumn.

BETULA X PLETTKEI 'GOLDEN TREASURE'

Golden Treasure Dwarf Birch • ZONE 2, HT 3-4', SP 2-3', SUN/PT SUN

A dwarf birch hybrid with pleasing, golden-orange new growth that fades to chartreuse. Maintains color well throughout the summer. Naturally mounding habit can be left alone or pruned for hedging. Deer resistant and drought tolerant once established.

CHAMAECYPARIS OBTUSA 'WELLS SPECIAL'

Hinooki Cypress • ZONE 4, HT 12-15', SP 5-7', SUN

A superior selection of Hinooki cypress noted for its emerald green foliage and tall, slightly narrow growth habit. This plant requires no pruning, is very slow growing, and lends a wonderfully delicate texture to the landscape.

CORNUS ALBA 'NEON BURST'

Siberian Dogwood • ZONE 2, HT 4-5', SP 4-5', SUN/PT SUN

Electric yellow foliage bursts onto the scene in spring and fades a lovely chartreuse for the summer. Fall foliage combines shades of purple, red, orange and yellow. Winter stems are bright red and contrast nicely with the new growth in spring.

EUONYMUS KIAUTSCHOVICUS 'MANHATTAN'

Wintercreeper • ZONE 5, HT 4', SP 6', SUN/SHADE

This evergreen, glossy-leafed climber is a versatile and handsome plant. It can grow as a ground cover or as a vine if trained up a wall or structure. This cultivar has increased resistance to scale, and is tolerant of poor soils and urban conditions.

HAMAMELIS X INTERMEDIA 'DIANE'

Hybrid Witch Hazel • ZONE 5, HT 8-12', SP 10-15', SUN/PT SUN

A highly prized winter witch hazel with red flowers, spicy fragrance, and phenomenal fall foliage. One of the earliest blooms every year, witch hazels typically herald the first spring tease. They also tolerate clay soil and are not bothered by deer.

***ILEX VERTICILLATA 'BERRY HEAVY GOLD'**

Winterberry-Female • ZONE 3, HT 6-8', SP 6-8', SUN/PART SUN

Large, bright gold berries make a spectacular sight in the winter garden. This golden-berried version of our native winterberry is a great food source for birds and pollinators alike. Needs a male winterberry to set fruit. We suggest the variety 'Jim Dandy.'

PHILADELPHUS LEWISII 'BUCKLEY'S QUILL'

Mockorange • ZONE 4, HT 5-6', SP 3-4', SUN

This double-flowered mockorange is very floriferous and exceptionally fragrant. The long skinny petals are unusual for the genus and add a delightful texture when it's covered in blooms. An extremely adaptable plant that can handle almost any adverse soils.

PICEA OMORIKA 'PIMOKO'

Dwarf Serbian Spruce • ZONE 4, HT 1-2', SP 1-2', SUN

'Pimoko' is a true dwarf in every sense. Diminutive foliage and habit make this an incredibly adorable selection that would be perfect for the rock garden, container planting, or bonsai specimen. Two-tone needles are accented by reddish brown buds.

RHODODENDRON 'WHITE LIGHTS'

Deciduous Azalea • ZONE 3, HT 4-5', SP 4-5', SUN/PART SHADE

Extremely hardy azalea of notable beauty and floriferous nature. A real showstopper when in bloom. Flowers are shell pink with faint golden markings as they open and quickly fade to almost pure white. Excellent bronzy-purple fall color.

***RHUS TYPHINA 'LACINIATA'**

Cutleaf Staghorn Sumac • ZONE 3, HT 12-15', SP 15-20', SUN/PT SUN

An ornamental selection of our familiar staghorn sumac, 'Laciniata', sports deeply lobed leaflets creating an exotic appearance. Great wildlife benefits and absolutely stunning orange and red fall foliage. Easy to grow and highly adaptable.

ROSA 'LOTTY'S LOVE'

Rosa Rugosa Hybrid • ZONE 3, HT 4-6.5', SP 3-4', SUN

With a more refined habit and a heavier bloom, this award-winner is not your grandmother's rosa rugosa. Semi-double, rich magenta flowers bear a strong cinnamon spice fragrance and are produced in abundance. Salt tolerant and disease resistant.

ROSA 'CAMPFIRE'

Landscape Rose • ZONE 3, HT 3', SP 3', SUN

'Campfire' is brand new rose that will burn bright in your landscape all season long. Super hardy and bred for excellent disease resistance, 'Campfire' continually produces masses of red/yellow buds that open to deep pink flowers with yellow centers.

ROSA 'HARLOW CARR'

David Austin Rose • ZONE 4, HT 3-4', SP 3-4', SUN

An exceptionally healthy and disease-resistant rose from the David Austin line. This vigorous shrub rose produces large quantities of highly fragrant, perfectly formed, pure pink flowers. Reliable repeat bloomer.

SALIX ALBA 'FLAME'

Flame Willow • ZONE 4, HT 12-15', SP 10-12', SUN

A shrub willow grown for its blazing red winter stems. Highly adaptable but will produce brighter stems in full sun. Coppice annually to produce more stems with brighter color. Makes a fantastic addition to the winter garden and floral arrangement.

***SALIX CANDIDA 'ICEBERG ALLEY'**

Sageleaf Willow • ZONE 2, HT 5', SP 5', SUN

A fantastic selection of a Vermont native. This willow is a wetland species and should be planted accordingly. Fuzzy silver foliage adds great contrast to the garden and floral arrangements alike. Tolerates alkaline soils.

SALIX ELAEAGNOS

Rosemary Willow • ZONE 4, HT 15', SP 15', SUN

A finely textured willow with narrow, pointed leaves reminiscent of rosemary. The silvery undersides create a pleasing visual effect when blown in the wind. Can be cut hard to keep more manageable or pruned to create a handsome small tree.

***SAMBUCUS RACEMOSA 'LEMONY LACE'**

Ornamental Elderberry • ZONE 3, HT 3-5', SP 3-5', SUN/PT SUN

This ornamental elderberry is sure to provide some interest. Bright lemon-yellow foliage is finely lobed and creates amazing texture in the landscape. Prune when young for a fuller habit in maturity. Tolerates clay soil and is deer resistant.

SYMPHORICARPOS X CHENAULTII 'HANCOCK'

Coralberry (Groundcover) • ZONE 4, HT 1-2', SP 5-10', SUN/PT SUN

This hybrid of coralberry species is superb at bank stabilization, and tolerates a wide range of conditions with ease. It also provides excellent nectar for pollinators as well as winter food for birds but deer won't bother it.

VIBURNUM CARLESII 'SPICE ISLAND'

Compact Korean Spice Viburnum • ZONE 4, HT 4-5', SP 4-5', SUN/PT SUN

When warm spring winds bring life to your garden, let them also bring delightful aromas of vanilla and spice from your very own 'Spice Island'. Uniform, compact habit makes this an easy fit in any landscape. Fiery red to burgundy fall foliage.

***VIBURNUM PRUNIFOLIUM**

Black Haw Viburnum • ZONE 4, HT 12-15', SP 6-12', SUN/PT SUN

A native large shrub or small tree, Black haw is a wonderful naturalizing species for windbreaks and hedgerows. Flowers benefit pollinators and fruit feeds wildlife. Tolerant of clay soils and drought. Red to maroon fall foliage.

***WISTERIA MACROSTACHYA 'BLUE MOON'**

Kentucky Wisteria • ZONE 4, HT VARIABLE', SP VARIABLE', SUN/PT SUN

Kentucky wisteria is native to the Southeast, but 'Blue Moon' was bred to thrive in the North as well. Stunning, foot-long, lavender-blue, fragrant flowers are produced multiple times a year! Grows fast and large so give it something sturdy to climb.
