### **ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM 'VIRIDIS'**

Laceleaf Japanese Maple • ZONE 5, HT 6-10', SP 6-10', SUN/PT SUN

One of the best specimen plants available. This lace-leaf Japanese maple has a delicate airy texture that contrasts its strong growth. Bright green foliage turns a show-stopping combination of yellow, orange, and red in autumn.

### **\*ACER X FREEMANII 'ARMSTRONG'**

Columnar Freemanii Maple • ZONE 4, HT 40-50', SP 10-15', SUN

An upright, columnar cultivar good for tight spaces and urban landscapes. Fast growth rate with decidedly narrow and upright branching habit. Very tolerant of urban pollution and compacted soils.

### **AESCULUS X CARNEA 'FORT MCNAIR'**

Red Flowering Horsechestnut • ZONE 4, HT 30', SP 30', SUN

Outstanding display of large rosy red flower panicles in late spring backed by dark green disease resistant foliage. Makes a great small to medium-sized specimen tree. Tolerates alkaline soils.

### **\*CATALPA SPECIOSA 'HEARTLAND'**

Northern Catalpa • ZONE 4, HT 40-50', SP 20-25', SUN

Catalpa is an incredibly tough and adaptable tree but it has been often overlooked due to its irregular and unpredictable growth. 'Heartland' is a marked improvement, offering more uniform branching, darker green foliage, and a narrow, upright habit.

### \***CORNUS DRUMMONDII (TREEFORM)**

**Giant Graystem Dogwood** • ZONE 4, HT 15-20', SP 10-15', SUN/PT SUN

Giant grey dogwood is similar to our more familiar *Cornus racemosa*, but is superior when grown as a tree form because it suckers less. Makes a wonderful small tree for humans and wildlife alike. Spring flowers, summer berries, and purple fall foliage.

### **FAGUS SYLVATICA 'RED OBELISK'**

**European Beech** • ZONE 4, HT 25-30', SP 5-10', SUN

A fantastic selection of European beech, 'Red Obelisk' maintains a desirable columnar habit which is easy to find space for, even in smaller landscapes. Attractive red to maroon foliage lasts all season and provides an excellent accent in the garden.

### **FAGUS SYLVATICA 'RIVERSII'**

**Purple European Beech** • ZONE 4, HT 30-50', SP 30-50', SUN/PT SUN

A magnificent, and long-lived specimen tree that has been in cultivation for hundreds of years. Glossy dark purple foliage is stunning in the landscape. The winter outline is particularly handsome with superb branching and smooth, light grey bark.

### **FAGUS SYLVATICA 'TRICOLOR'**

**European Beech** • ZONE 4, HT 40-60', SP 40-50', SUN/PT SUN

A striking cultivar of European beech noted for its foliage, which emerges with bright pink margins surrounding a deep purple center. The variegation will hold better with a little shade during summer months. Golden yellow fall foliage.

### **GINKGO BILOBA 'GOLDSPIRE'**

Columnar Maidenhair • ZONE 4, HT 14-18', Sp 5-6', SUN

Dense columnar habit makes this an excellent selection for smaller landscapes. 'Goldspire' packs all the aesthetics of its larger brethren but opens the door for novel uses like large container plantings or vertical accent in smaller gardens.

### **GINKGO BILOBA 'PRESIDENTIAL GOLD'**

Maidenhair Tree • ZONE 4, HT 40-50', SP 30-40', SUN

A new selection from Dr. Dirr of the U. of Georgia, 'Presidential Gold' is noted for its strong central leader and dense branching when young. Male cultivar so no messy fruit. The fall foliage is pure golden yellow. Ginkgos are highly adaptable.

### **\*GYMNOCLADUS DIOECUS 'ESPRESSO'**

Kentucky Coffeetree • ZONE 4, HT 40-50', SP 30-35', SUN

An underutilized tree with great potential, Kentucky coffeetree is noted for its huge doubly-pinnate leaves which give it a slightly tropical appearance. 'Espresso' is a male selection (no messy fruit) with handsome bluish-green foliage.

### **MAGNOLIA X 'YELLOW LANTERN'**

Yellow Magnolia • ZONE 4, HT 20-25', SP 15-20', SUN

Light up your spring landscape with this wonderful yellow-flowered magnolia. 'Yellow Lantern' grows quickly and blooms at a young age. Large, fragrant flowers open just as the leaves begin to emerge. A sultry specimen for the discerning gardener.

### **MALUS 'GOLDEN RAINDROPS'**

Crabapple • ZONE 3, HT 15-20', SP 12-15', SUN

Superior disease resistance is why this plant has made it into our fields. Gorgeous pure white flowers, cut-leaf foliage, and prolific golden crabapples are why we think it will be a favorite of yours. Tremendous year-round appeal and easy to grow.

### **\*NYSSA SYLVATICA 'FORUM'**

Black Gum • ZONE 4, HT 40-50', SP 20-30', SUN

A selection of black gum with more uniform growth and branching than the species. Still retains all of the redeeming qualities like tolerance of wet soils, huge benefits to pollinators (and beekeepers), and fall foliage worth writing home about.

### **PINUS KORAIENSIS 'JACK KORBIT'**

Korean Pine • ZONE 3, HT 6-8', SP 3-4', SUN

Very hardy and slow growing, 'Jack Korbit' is a great addition to the northern conifer connoisseur's collection. Blue-green, two-tone needles develop a narrow band of yellow accent in the foliage. Ornamental cones add to the appeal.

### **PRUNUS SUBHIRTILLA 'SNOW GOOSE'**

Flowering Cherry • ZONE 5, HT 20-25', SP 15-20', SUN

'Snow Goose' arrives in the spring with a wonderful display of pure white flowers before the leaves emerge. Blooms develop a tinge of red in the center as they mature. This cultivar is more disease resistant than most cherry trees.

### **SALIX MATSUDANA 'SCARLET CURLS'**

Contorted Willow • ZONE 4, HT 15-20', SP 12-15', SUN

'Scarlet Curls' is a contorted willow with bright red winter stems, making it a great choice for garden texture and color, as well as cut stems. Can be pruned as a small tree or coppiced for more cut stems. Easy to grow and highly ornamental.

### **\*TAXODIUM DISTICHUM**

Bald Cypress • ZONE 4, HT 50-70, SP 20-40', SUN

A truly unique species that is underutilized in our area. A wetland specialist, it's tolerant of heavy, poorly drained soils, and can live in standing water. One of the few deciduous conifers, needles turn russet-red before dropping in fall.
