BASIL

Amethyst

The only purple Genovese basil, it has large ruffled 2-3" leaves with edible flowers.

Aristotle

A compact, very fragrant, and highly disease-resistant basil.

Floral Spires

Well-structured with highly ornamental, cinnamon Thai basil fragrance.

Dolce Fresca

AAS award-winning, sweet, delicious, compact habit, and vigorous growth. Genovese type.

Everleaf Emerald Tower

Large 2-3" leaves with tall 24" height make this ideal for cooks who love basil. It has a resistance to Fusarium and Downy Mildew, and is not prone to bolting.

Everleaf Genevise

Robust flavor and ideal for season-long harvesting, this selection is also resistant to Fusarium and Downy Mildew.

Nufar

A Genovese type with large flavorful leaves. Nufar is the first basil ever to be resistant to Fusarium Wilt.

BAY LAUREL

Bay Laurel

These evergreen trees can be grown in potted arrangements and brought into a well-lit indoor environment during the winter. Add aromatic leaves whole to homemade pasta sauces and soups.

CHIVES

Chinese Broadleaf

A traditional broadleaf chive with slight hints of garlic flavor.

Garlic

This chive packs a powerful garlic flavor, with traditional culinary uses.

Onion

The bulbs can be used with this chive but the tops make a great addition to any recipe.

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OREGANO



Greek

The true oregano that grows wild in Greece. Very intense flavor, a choice herb for use in Italian cooking. Can also be used as a healing wash for burns, rashes, blisters and poison ivy.



Italian

Strongly aromatic and flavorful, dark green leaves, with small white flowers.



Hot and Spicy

A robust 24-36" spread and hardy to zone 5, this cold and heat tolerant oregano is prolific and an easy choice for your herb garden bed.



PARSLEY

Italian

Flat, flavorful green leaves are high in iron and vitamins A, C, and E. Some say that its flavor holds up better than curly parsley.

Moss Curled

Used as a classic garnish on dishes, it also has high nutritional value. It is frost tolerant and can be used as a texture plant in arrangements.

Darki

Great for cooking and garnishes, this dark green upright plant is hardy and tolerates light frost.



ROSEMARY

Barbecue

This fragrant, upright rosemary has attractive blue blooms during the summer, and is ideal for cooking and barbeques. Its straight stems can be used as skewers.

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SAGE

Purple

Ornamental herb with attractive purple foliage and beautiful violet flower spikes. Easy maintenance and versatile in your kitchen.

Tricolor

Colorful grayish green leaves with white, pink, and purple variegation. Strong aroma, this sage is very attractive to bees and butterflies.

Pineapple

With large, salvia-like growth habit, this beauty of an annual has pungent aromas of pineapple and citrus and makes a great addition to any meal that calls for sage.



SAVORY

Winter

Not to be confused with 'summer savory', which is a vigorous, flavorless annual. Winter Savory is a tiny, woody shrub that grows best in poor, dry, well-drained soil. Prune all summer long and enjoy the flavorful leaves fresh or dried with chicken, rice, potatoes, and in salad dressings.



TARRAGON

French

A culinary classic. Most popular in fish and poultry dishes.



THYME

Lemon Variegated

Green and gold-edged foliage has a strong lemon flavor and is used in marinades and more.

Silver Edged

A perennial thyme with mounding habit, silver-edged leaves, and purple flowers in summer. Also makes a great ground cover.

English

Aside from its culinary purpose, it attracts early season butterflies, as well as beneficial flies and bees.
