BEETS

Bulls Blood
(40-52 days)

Large, purplish red beets with edible red foliage. 2-3" fruit.



BROCCOLI

Early Dream
(59 days)

Large-domed, tight-beaded, heat tolerant variety.

Green Magic
(57 days)

Medium-sized smooth broccoli heads that are 5-6" large. Heat-tolerant.



BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Jade Cross
(80 days)

An early hybrid with uniform growth and delicious taste!



CANTELOUPE

Early Delicious 51
(75 days)

A 2-3 lb canteloupe variety with prolific yields, tasty flavor, and strong aroma.



CUCUMBER

Boston Pickling
(54 days)

A favorite of home gardeners. Self-fertile vines bearing 6" cucumbers.

Marketmore 76
(63 days)

Long, slender, dark green cucumbers. Has been the standard for slicing cucumbers with 8-9" fruits. Begins bearing late but picks for a relatively long time.

Gherking
(58-62 days)

A medium-sized cucumber that is delicious pickled, cooked, or eaten fresh.



EGGPLANT

Classic
(65-85 days)

Egg-shaped, purple to green fruit 6-9" long.

Hanzel
(55 days)

All-American Selections winner, great for containers, 4-8" fruit with little seeds.

▶ **GROUND CHERRY**

Aunt Molly
(65 days)

This tomatillo variety is plentiful and robust. Sweet, bright orange fruit inside a light orange husk. Delicious fresh or baked in tarts.

▶ **KALE**

Dynasaur
(55-60 days)

Also know as Tuscan kale, this blue-green kale is rich in flavor and one of the best!

Scarlet
(80 days)

Ruffled, reddish purple, tightly curled leaf.

Red Russian
(55-60 days)

The best early season and late season leafy green you could ask for! Ornamental red stems make this perfect for planting within flowers.

▶ **LETTUCE**

Bistro Gourmet Mix
(55 days)

A nice variety of color and leaf types, a great option for all-around salad greens.

Blushed Icy Oak
(50-55 days)

Red and green-colored lettuce with a refreshing snappy crunch.

Buttercrunch
(60-65 days)

All-American Selections winner with cupped lush greens and a buttery texture. Perfect for lettuce wraps.

▶ ▶ **PEPPER**

Golden California Wonder
(62-73 days)

Smooth, blocky 4" fruit. Sweet and mild flavor, turn light green to light yellow.

Hungarian Cheese Blend
(60 days)

A great snacking/stuffing pepper of varying color during maturity. Fruit size is roughly 4" and has a quick maturity.

Purple Beauty
(65-70 days)

Guaranteed to catch the eye, these roughly 4" fruit have a rich deep purple appearance and great bell flavor.

Sweet Banana
(70 days)

A very popular large-pointed pepper roughly 6-7" in size. Mild in heat and flavor, they have a variety of culinary purpose and are most popular as a pickling pepper.

▶ **PEPPER** *(continued)*
 Orange Marmalade (55-60 days green; 70-75 days orange) A delicious medium-sized bell pepper with sweet flavor and great disease resistance.

▶ **PEPPER - SPICY**
 Habanero (95-100 days) Very hot, spicy and smokey quality. Good for chilis and hot sauces. Plants produce many 1-2" fruits.

Jalapeno (72 days) The most popular chili pepper in America. Thick walled, 3" fruit mature with varying green and red coloration. Mild heat.

Poblano (65 days) A mildly hot, 4" dark purple/green pepper perfect for roasting and stuffing. Dry to make ancho peppers.

Red Cherry Hot (80 days) Small 1-2" fruit are mild when green, and much hotter as they mature to a dark red.

▶ **SQUASH - SUMMER**
 Gold Summer Crook Neck (50 days) Very prolific, smooth-skinned golden yellow fruit. We love them best when picked at 4-6" size.

Straight Neck (46-52 days) A prolific heirloom, creamy yellow, straight-neck squash that is great for grilling. Fruit size is 4 to 10" and matures quickly.

▶ **SQUASH - WINTER**
 Delicata (80-100 days) With similar flavor to a sweet potato, these cream-colored winter squash are oblong in shape with beautiful green striping. Squash are 6" long, 3" diameter.

Honey Bear Acorn (85 days) Medium-sized acorn squash are roughly 1-2lbs. They have a wonderful sweet starchy texture good for baking and stuffing. This variety was bred for powdery mildew resistance.

Waltham Butternut (82 days) Heirloom, with a hard yellow to tan exterior and sweet orange flesh. Winter squash size is 1 to 3 lb.

TOMATO

Beefmaster
(80 days)

Huge meaty fruits are amazing for slicing and sandwiches. Tolerant of cracking with mild and sweet flavor. Hybrid. Indeterminate.

Black Krim
(80 days)

Dark, reddish-purple fruit with a sweet flavor. Determinate.

Brandywine Red
(90 days)

Overall winner of flavor, these beefsteak-shaped, boat-like fruit are 12-16 oz in size. Indeterminate.

Bush Early Girl
(65 days)

Extra large, super early tomato has proven to be resistant to many common tomato diseases. Great for patio planters, 6oz fruit. Determinate.

Celebrity
(70 days)

A versatile, disease-resistant tomato with excellent flavor. Average fruit size of 7 oz. Determinate.

Cherokee Purple
(85 days)

Dark purple, heirloom beefsteak tomato with smokey full flavor. Large 12-16 oz. fruit size. Indeterminate.

Heirloom Rainbow Blend
(80-100 days)

An old fashioned, very flavorful variety of yellow, green, and red tomatoes. Medium size at 6-10 oz. Indeterminate.

Mountain Merit
(75 days)

A classic disease and pest-resistant All-America Selections regional winner. Weighing in at 8-10 oz, mild flavor, it has a strong heat tolerance. Determinate

Peardrops
(75 days)

Enjoy high yields of orange tangy-flavored fruits. Pear-shaped fruit are 2-4 oz. Indeterminate.

TOMATO - CHERRY

Sunsugar
(65 days)

Sweettart-flavored cherry tomato that produces all season long. Golden orange fruit roughly 1 oz. Indeterminate.

Super Sweet 100
(70 days)

Very sweet, scarlet-colored cherry size fruit are 1 oz. Indeterminate.

▶ **TOMATO - CHERRY** *(continued)*
Sungold (65 days) A great orange cherry tomato with a sweet and tart flavor. Indeterminate.

▶ **ZUCCHINI**
Elite (48 days) This early zucchini has impressive yields and is easy to pick. 7-8" in length.

▶ **WATERMELON**
Sugar Baby (75 days) Sweet, medium-red flesh, round in shape and average 6-12 lbs. A good option for a short growing season.
